

Eligibility	 Not owning pucca house anywhere in India Belonging to EWS (Income below ₹ 3 lakh)(W.B. – ₹ 2.16 lakh) LIG and MIG eligible for only Interest Subsidy Scheme-ISS (Income upto ₹ 9 lakh) Not availing benefit of housing scheme in last 20 years
Permissible size of House	Minimum of 30 sqm upto 45 sqm (ISS: upto 120 sqm)
Special Focus on	Beneficiaries of PM-SVANidhi & PM Vishwakarma, Safai Karmchari, BoCW, Anganwadi Workers and other identified groups

Eligibility	 i. For EWS – 1.20 lakh/annum ii. Inhabitant of same urban areas. iii. Not owning a pucca house anywhere in India 		







Implementation Period	01.04.2014
Financial Assistance / Sharing	As State Sponsored Scheme, recast on the pattern of Indira Awas Yojna (IAY)
Eligibility	Citizen belongs from Urban Poor category. (Income below ₹ 1.80 lakh/annum)
Permissible size of House	The DUs are in the pattern of IAY along with low cost toilet provided by District authority.
Special Focus on	 Poor people in Erosion / Flood / other calamities affected / disaster porn areas. Poor people affected by Government project (as per rehabilitation measures)





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IHSDP & BSUP (JNNURM)



Implementation Period	2005 to 2014
Financial Assistance / Sharing	Central, State & Beneficiary
Eligibility	 Not owning pucca house anywhere in India Belonging to EWS Not availing benefit of housing scheme in last 20 years
Permissible size of House	25 sqm with preferably two room accommodation plus kitchen and toilet should be constructed.



Some affordable Housing indicatives



Affordable housing in Gitabitan, Birbhum



Status	At present, in the complex of Gitabitan Township there are 112 no. of EWS housing units completed fully and ready to handover.
Criteria for selection of the beneficiaries	 10 % of the aforesaid units may be reserved for the land losers who are eligible to get EWS housing as per the present policy of the State Government i.e. the monthly family income should be Rs.18,000/- or below. The applicants would have to be having domicile certificate of Birbhum district.
Criteria for distribution	 Entire distribution shall be made on lottery system The cost towards EWS unit is Rs. 7.84 lacs, out of which Rs.4.29 lacs would be borne by the Government and the rest would be paid by the beneficiary. The lock-in period for 15 years.



Affordable housing in Newtown



Status	The project is under Smart City Mission and subsidized with PMAY and State plan fund.
Criteria for selection of the beneficiaries	 Income criteria for EWS may be 25000/- PM. Though there is a notification under this Department where Rs 18000/- has been fixed as upper limit for family income of EWS, due to the escalation of price of EWS units, the income criteria may be Rs 25000/- as per the PMAY For LIG, the monthly income criteria may be as per the notification issued by the Housing Department. Presently, as per notification of the Housing department dated 21.12.2023, the
	monthly income eligibility is Rs 40,000/- per month for carpet area of flat 350 sq ft to 500 sq ft. And maximum sale price per sq ft area is Rs 4100/-
Criteria for distribution	 Allotment of EWS units shall be done adopting a transparent procedure, preferably through lottery system. Price for EWS units may be fixed at Rs.l0.00 lakh/unit. There shall be a locking period of 15 years within which period sale of the flats would not be allowed.



Ease of doing Business



State Level Investment Synergy Committee (SLISC)

Chaired by the Chief Secretary of the State with Head of the following Departments, Directorates and Organizations

- Single-Point Interface: Centralized platform for all investment proposals.
- Facilitate Timely Approvals: Time-bound clearances (a maximum period of one month) for building plans, drainage, water, pollution control, fire safety, labour, and electricity.
- Eliminate Bottlenecks: Facilitate interdepartmental coordination through 'Samannay' portal for speedy resolution of inter-departmental issues.
- Support Investments across Sectors: Cater to diverse sectors.
- **Real-Time Monitoring:** Enable real-time tracking of application status to expedite decision-making and fast-track approvals.
- Grievance Redressal Mechanism: online system for grievance redressal and feedback.
- **Data Integration:** Integrate with other related online portals to create a comprehensive information repository for investors.

Note: Similar structure has been constituted at District level led by **District Magistrate**.








Online Building Plan Approval System






Qualifications & criteria: (i) at least Secondary level education (ii) belonging to same locality & knowledge of local issues (iii) used to working in android-based mobile.

Training:

- (i) Geo-tagging
- (ii) Site inspection (Social engineering)
- (iii) Monitoring & Reporting

Value Addition

- a. Verify the Dwelling Units physically & update report every week.
- b. Identifies the bottleneck of progress of Dwelling Units, prioritize issues & take initiatives for suitable and quick resolution.
- c. Facilitate the progress of ongoing DUs on time.
- d. Apart from the assigned work, they may be deputed in other survey activities depending on their capabilities and to enhance income generation.
